Chairman Curtis presented the Hazardous Materials Emergency Planning (HMEP) Training Grant Application for submittal to the State Emergency Response Commission (SERC) by September 14, 2009. This grant cycle comes up each year and all LEPC's are able to apply for training and planning funds. Earlier this year the Hazmat Explo previously held in Las Vegas, Nevada was cancelled. The SERC has been working to add a Hazmat Track to the Silver State Safety and Hazmat Conference which will be held in Reno in November 2009. The total grant is for training only to send 14 personnel to attend this conference and the cost is \$3,780.00. The Storey County Fire Department has additional Hazmat Technicians and we will also be sending private industry LEPC Members. The grant includes conference registration, per diem, and mileage.

Motion for approval of the HMEP Training Grant Application for submittal to the State of Nevada Emergency Response Commission (SERC) was made by Pat Whitten. This motion was seconded by Gary Hames. All present in favor. Motion carries.
